- In 2013, it was a team event for young people, on the themes of Recycling, the Natural World etc; with commentaries alongside each photograph

The structure is made of recycled plastic bottles tied to chicken wire to create a half globe that would represent our planet and its synthetic and manmade damages and restrictions, but the candles to show that there is not a loss of hope.

## Example Entry: "Life from Decay"



After the long, cold winter nature will once more create new life and beauty from death in its endless cycle of renewal.

We too are trying to form new ways of life (shown by the white snowdrops) from the old polluting ways of the recent past (represented by the decaying leaves) - the cycle of nature through sustainability.
