Guidelines – 2022

Environment/Voluntary Group Exhibits – voluntary contribution

Spring Greens Fair is essentially a local, participatory networking event.

We encourage organisations to promote their activities through informative exhibits educational and engaging activities which reflect this year's Re-Turn, Re-Spond, Re-Connect & Re-Store vibe.

Local maker/producer - £25 for the wknd or £15 per day

Crafts, arts & other local products are welcome. (Local = within 30 miles)

Food Stalls - please contact Tori to avoid over-stocking!

The cost of a stall is £100 for a standard pitch and £50 for a small pitch to be paid in advance.

Sustainable Businesses - £100

Exhibits by local green businesses or service providers. Please pay £50 in advance as a booking fee.

Fairly traded and ethically sourced imports (please no exploitative crap or rubbish!)

Could you offer an engaging activity that relates to your work and in some way reflects this year, Re-Sprung?

Please try to provide your own dry & inviting shelters. We can't offer covered space for homeless exhibits!

Zero Waste – Please use only re-useable or compostable packaging.

If completely unavoidable, you should responsibly remove and dispose of any waste arising.

Arrive on Friday after 4pm, or before 9am Sat/Sun to find your place and set up.

Depart after 6pm on Saturday or Sunday or at other times by arrangement.

Camping Stall-holders, exhibitors, contributors and crew may stay over-nights (Friday to Sunday)

Risk Assessment Forms please provide your Risk Assessment in advance by email or by-hand to Emma Bulmer (Healthy & Safe Steward) soon after your arrival.
